The Ins & Outs of Ontario Regulation 20/17

In February 2017, the Government of Ontario passed Regulation 20/17: Reporting of Energy Consumption and Water Use, as part of the province's action plan to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Certain commercial, industrial and multi-residential buildings 50,000 sq. ft. or larger are now required to report their energy and water use annually.

ANNUAL REPORTING ON:

- Water
- Electricity
- ► Gas, and/or
- Fuel usage data

Are you required to report?



Reporting is required if you have a:

- Commercial or industrial building or a multi-residential building with more than 10 units; and
- The building is 50,000 sq. ft. or larger



You are exempt from reporting if your building is any of the following:1

- Already reporting Greenhouse Gas Emissions under Ontario Regulation 143/16
- Occupied by public agency (>50% of building²)
- Occupied by data centre, TV studio or trading floor (>10% of building²)
- Occupied by processing facilities for manufacturing, commercial, agricultural or industrial processing (>10% of building²)
- Newly constructed with a certificate of occupancy issued in the applicable reporting year
- Less than 50% occupied in the applicable reporting year²

July 1, 2018	2017	≥ 250,000 sq. ft.	Not required
July 1, 2019	2018	\geq 100,000 sq. ft.	\geq 100,000 sq. ft.
July 1, 2020	2019	≥ 50,000 sq. ft.	≥ 50,000 sq. ft.

How to report



- Building location and ownership
- Building square footage
- Occupancy and space usage
- Annual water, electricity, gas and/or fuel usage data



Data verification must be completed in the first year and every five years by an accredited body or certified professional
