**1** Your **Account Number** identifies you as a unique Enercare customer. Please reference this number when making a payment and setting up your online account at MyEnercare.ca.

**2** **Electricity** is the cost of the electricity supplied to the service address during this billing period.

**3** **Global Adjustment** (if applicable) is a charge or credit to customers who pay Hourly Ontario Energy Price (HOEP) or electricity retailer rates. Global Adjustment fluctuates from month to month and covers the cost for providing adequate generating capacity and conservation programs in Ontario. Global Adjustment rates are set by the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO). Generally speaking, when HOEP is lower, then Global Adjustment is higher in order to cover additional costs.

**4** Electricity **Delivery** charges are the costs of delivery electricity from generating stations to your utility and then to your home or business. This also includes the costs associated with providing metered services to your home or business. A portion of these charges are fixed and do not change from month to month. The rest are variable and increase or decrease depending on the amount of electricity you use.

**5** **Regulatory Charges** are the costs of administering the wholesale electricity system and maintaining the reliability of the provincial grid and include the costs associated with funding Ministry of Energy conservation and renewable energy programs. **6** The **Debt Retirement Charge** (DRC) pays down the debt of the former Ontario Hydro. As part of its commitment to reduce electricity cost pressures, the Government of Ontario is removing the DRC from applicable residential bills after December 31, 2015 and may apply to you.

**7** Effective January 1, 2017, the Ontario Government is providing a **8% Provincial Rebate** on your electricity costs equal to the provincial portion of HST.

**8** **Water and Sewage Usage** is the cost of supplying and delivering water and related services to your home or business and other charges from your local water utility provider.

**9** Water, thermal and gas delivery charges are for the cost of metered services supplied. Within delivery, the **administration fee** covers the costs related to billing, customer care, collections and general administrative

services. The **meter and data fee, distribution usage fee, and/or distribution charge** portion represents the cost of installing, maintaining and reading meters for a specific service.

**Thermal Usage** is the cost of supplying and delivering thermal energy to heat or cool your home or business. Your bill may show a heating charge or cooling charge, or both, depending on the usage in the month.

**Gas Usage** represents the cost of supplying and delivering gas to your home or business.

**12**

The **service setup charge** is an administration charge applied to new Enercare accounts.

**13**

New customers are required to pay a security deposit unless they meet the security deposit waiver conditions outlined in the Conditions of Service found at MyEnercare.ca. The deposit is applied to your account over six equal monthly installments, appearing as a **Deposit Installment Plan**.

**14** The **Read Type** explains how your electricity usage data was collected for the billing period. 'ACT' indicates that the read was based on actual consumption. 'EST' will appear if your consumption was estimated.

**15** The **Loss Factor** accounts for a small amount of electricity lost to heat while travelling over transmission lines.

**16** The **Adjusted Usage**, which is used to determine part of your electricity delivery charge, is calculated by taking the electricity usage data and applying a loss factor.

**17** Water consumption, shown as **Usage Litre**, is measured by taking the meter data read from the current date minus that of the previous read date.

**18** Thermal energy used, measured in megajoules (MJ), is calculated using the meter data read from the current date minus that of the previous read date.

**19** The **Adjusted Usage** is your total gas consumption for the billing period. This is calculated by taking the usage data read by the meter and applying a pressure correction factor. Volume of gas varies depending on the elevation and pressure of gas supplied. The volume of gas varies depending on the atmospheric pressure and the pressure at which the gas is supplied. The pressure correction factor accounts for these conditions to find the actual amount of gas consumed.
